Multi-item kits


Multi-item kits have items that need to be mixed together or used in a particular order for them to work.

- anti-ageing or revitalising kits







- 2 suspected to be CMRs, based on some human or animal studies









- 4) You can make amendments to an existing portal registration if you change your formulation (and have the change assessed) you can update the existing registration.
- 5) If you are unsure of anything you need to include ask your assessor, we can help you with the registration.
- 6) You must register ALL products to be sold or given away in the UK.
- 7) This portal does not apply to product to be sold or given away in the EU; a separate portal exists for these products.
